What can go in your Green bin

Yes please: Garden Waste

Garden plants and weeds, hedge trimmings, small branches and bark, leaves and grass cuttings, house plants and compost. Bedding from vegetarian pets e.g. rabbits, guinea pigs.

Yes please: Cardboard

Cardboard of any type including cereal and food boxes. Please flatten cardboard boxes and remove staples and any packaging tape. Please do not include cartons with plastic, wax or foil coatings such as orange juice cartons.

Yes please: Kitchen Waste

Vegetable peelings, fruit peel and cores, cooked or uncooked meat, fish and bones, tea bags, coffee grounds, any other food scraps (cooked or uncooked). All kitchen waste can be wrapped in newspaper or put into an uncoated cardboard box and placed in your Garden Bin. The paper or cardboard will be composted with the garden and kitchen waste.

At our last meeting we considered the future of the outside store which is currently let as a workshop. Back in 1997 plans were drawn up for a first floor development to give extra meeting space. This was shelved in the original refurbishment scheme and the old one storey building was left as it was.

The Committee feels the time has come to revisit the issue because the workshop space needs refurbishment if it is to be lettable in future and the asbestos roof needs replacing with modern materials. Refurbishment could probably be done within our present budget but a complete rebuild of the extension would require us to look to outside grant-giving bodies to provide the capital.

We have set up a small sub-group to look at the options over the next few months.

All change with the Trains John Geddes

Trains from Matlock and Chesterfield are now run by East Midlands Trains (EMT), who replaced Central Trains and Midland Mainline on 11th November. There will be little change for now : the phone number for buying tickets is the same (08457 125678) but the website has changed to www.eastmidlandstrains.co.uk

In the medium term, one can hope that EMT might do better at running trains (rather than replacement buses) between Matlock and Derby. For the moment, this looks like a continuing problem - buses leave Matlock earlier than the train they replace, so you need to know before you leave home. To do this, check the National Rail website rather than Traveline (links from www.winstar.org) as changes sometimes get made at short notice, and Traveline are slow at catching up.

The real upside in the change of train operator comes in the longer term (from December 2008) when Matlock is promised an hourly train service to and from Nottingham.

But you can now going further, quicker

With Eurostar trains now running from St Pancras, you can now travel by train to Paris and Brussels from Chesterfield or Derby with a single change of trains at St Pancras. And the cost has come down, as through tickets are now available (from £77 return); these will be available online from mid December, or from 08705 186186.

Thanks to John for his updates about the Midland Mainline strike. I went to London for £7 (single) on the 8.40am from Chesterfield on 2nd November because my train to London was cancelled the previous evening.

But trying coming back from down south at the weekend at the moment—check the website—replacement buses from Derby to Chesterfield.

In April 2008 all people over 60 will be entitled to free bus travel after 9.30am and all day at the weekends and Bank Holidays.

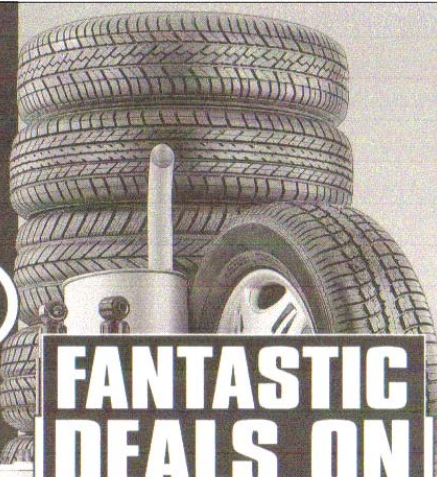

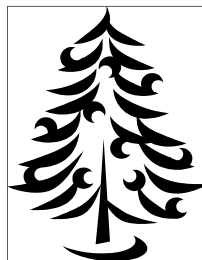

Secret Gardens 2997 Grant Application Results

Eight Winster groups applied for a share of the funds set aside from the diminished profits made from this year's Secret Gardens Weekend which was adversely affected by bad weather. The Burton Institute is the main recipient of funds raised by the event, and from the small profit made, The Secret Gardens Committee set aside £1,000 to be distributed to village groups. The Grant Allocation Committee is delighted to be able to give financial support to all those who applied. The applications covered a wide range of activities benefitting many age groups within Winster, and most people within the village will have connections with at least one of the groups below either directly or through a family member. The grants made are:

Playing Fields Association £200.

Darby and Joan Club. £75.

Pre-School £175.

Winster Village Choir £75.

Twining Group £125.

Luncheon Club £100.

Christmas Tree Lights Fund £50.

Winster Football Club £200.

In October 2007 Winster Entertainments Group, who benefited from a start-up grant last year, wrote to Secret Gardens giving an account of how they had been able to bring a variety of entertainments to the village. Through their hard work the village has been able to enjoy quality, live entertainment in Winster but as a fledgling group trying to become established, they needed the financial support we were able to provide. 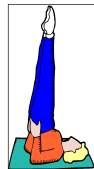
