## Winster Pond Update

Most of the new pond plants were put in on the 11th May. Thanks to Dan Clarke for helping with that. We were really pleased with the quality and quantity of plants and are looking forward to seeing them establish and develop over time. We planted a mix of deep water, floating, and emergent native plants which should really enrich the pond habitat. The next step with the pond is to create an information board. We are intending to involve Winster school children in the design of this. With the permission of the Parish Council, we hope to replace the existing rather intrusive big yellow warning sign and use the posts to mount an attractive and interesting information board that will enhance people's enjoyment of the pond. The community orchard project will be moving forward over the Summer, with the intention of putting trees in the ground through the planting season September-March. When we have agreed on suitable tree species, we hope to encourage people to sponsor trees to help fund their purchase. Please let us know if you would be interested in this. We hope to carry out some tree works at the end of the nesting season ahead of the woodland copse planting, which is likely to be spread over 2 seasons. 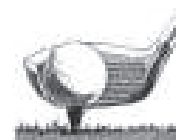

Small windows, letter boxes and cat flap may be big enough to reach through or property taken using fishing or hooking techniques, so don't leave anything of value nearby.

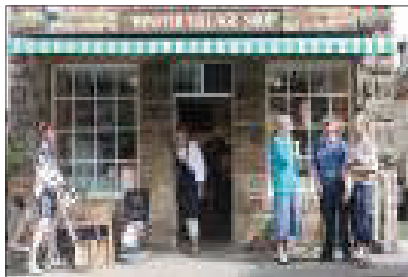
