### Bank and credit card scams

If you are telephoned suggesting that your credit card has been fraudulently used take care. What the scammers want is the 3-digit PIN number on the back of the card. Don't give it to them. Instead, tell them you'll call VISA or MasterCard directly for verification of their conversation. The real VISA told us that they will never ask for anything on the card as they already know the information since they issued the card!

A woman living in Tideswell contacted police when she received a letter saying a relative of hers had died in Spain and that she was entitled to some of the relative's money. The letter asked her to disclose her bank account details so the money could be transferred. Another scam.

A new service for victims and witnesses of anti-social behaviour has been launched in our area by Derbyshire County Council and national charity Victim Support.

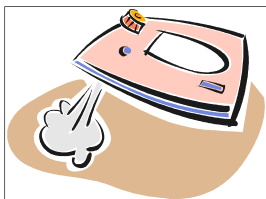
This means that Victim Support now gives confidential, emotional and practical support to people who are affected by anti-social behaviour.
