Matlock Bath – From Lead Mining To Tourism

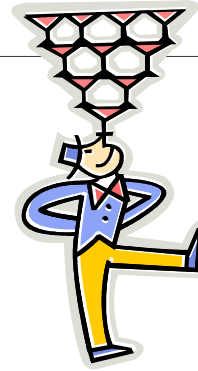
An opportunity to take a guided walk around the village of Matlock Bath, looking at how it has developed from a lead miners' settlement to a popular visitor attraction. The walk will take in the sites of the thermal baths, former show caves, public houses and museums. See Matlock Bath (with the help of old photographs), showing how much the village has changed, and how the arrival of the railway in 1849 transformed the village into a thriving inland tourist resort. The walk will be led by Tony Wood of Winster. Tony is an expert on local history and is currently Chair of the Peak District Mines Historical Society.

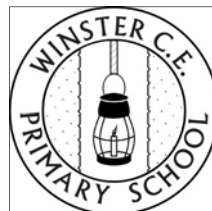
